Thanks to each and everyone who made a contribution to the collection and of course to those who took up the collection at the churches. I have a list of you all my good friends. Bless you always. The money arrived safe and sound here a few days after it was sent from the Bank in Ireland. A Million Thanks again'. Fr Johnny McEvoy. Some of the uses for this money: A fridge for a family with 6 children, Help with wages for workers to keep an old people's home open, A family house burned down here last week - will need some help to get them going again, upgrading the parish files, school fees and the need to provide an odd laptop here and there. Last year I was able to give 3 students a laptop each, There is always emergencies and requests for money when deaths occur in poor families. We always help out with a little. In fact the parish makes a small contribution to every parishioner that dies, Contributions to members of the youth to attend courses and seminars - always ongoing etc. And the list goes on and on - So thank you Rahan Parish. During the year the Columban provided an outboard 60HP engine \$10,000 for an Island Parish that we used to serve. We gave a loan of \$15,000 to complete a village church. We gave a grant of \$15,000 to build a new church in one of the outer Islands - who had no resident priest for the last 35 years. They have one now - he requires a computer now. We gave donations of \$5,000 to help with a church extension in one of our 1st parishes in Fiji. A \$1,000 to each of our Columban parishes to help the Vincent de Paul to look after some of their cases. So that is just a bit of background info for anyone interested
