Today's Gospel: Pope Francis speaking on The Father's Mercy . How beautiful is the Father's tenderness! The Father's mercy is overflowing, unconditional, and it is manifested before the son speaks. The son certainly knows he has erred and he acknowledges it: "I have sinned ... treat me as one of your hired servants But these words dissolve in face of the Father's forgiveness. His Father's embrace and kiss make him understand that he was always considered son, despite everything. This teaching of Jesus is important: for us as children of God. God's love and the love of God our Father's heart; it does not depend on our merits or our actions and, therefore, no one can take it away. In whatever situation of life, I must not forget that I will never cease to be a child of God, of a Father who loves me and awaits my return. Even in the most awful situation of life, God awaits me, God wants to embrace me, God loves me now and always
