Today we give thanks for the Eucharist, a celebration that has been happening since the very beginning of the Church. It seems to have been always celebrated the day after the Jewish Sabbath day, because this is the day the resurrection happened. This is significant, because not only does the Eucharist celebrate the death of Jesus but also recognizes His death as a phase in our salvation through the resurrection. The Jews celebrate the Passover. The Passover is the commemoration of the great saving event, the deliverance of Israel from slavery and its constitution as the people of God.
