Why should Jesus, at the age of thirty or so (the age at which Jewish Rabbis usually began to preach), submit to baptism at the hands of his cousin, John the Baptist, who announces and offers 'a baptism of repentance'? Jesus, being sinless, surely does not need to repent. Today's gospel does not tell us the reason, but we get the answer from Matthew's gospel where, in answer to the Baptist's protestations, Jesus insists, saying that 'it is fitting that we should fulfil all righteousness'. In other works, Jesus wants to identify with humankind in the fullest possible way, humbly joining the queue waiting John's baptism of repentance. All gospel accounts place more emphasis on what happens after the event than on the baptism itself. Luke stresses that the Holy Spirit descends on Jesus while he is at prayer. A voice from heaven proclaims that he is the beloved Son of God. He is anointed with the Holy Spirit and with power. His identity is confirmed
