Today's Gospel: Resurrection - A New Breakthrough: God breaks into life in a new way at our death. It happens in small ways every time we are transformed a bit when we forgive, make peace, really help another, when we promise ourselves to someone or something, this is an effect of the resurrection. But the final one is a gift unlike any earthly gift. We need to share this hope with each other. The peace you may have felt at the death of someone, the dream where the loved one was happy, the thanks you feel for another for ever all of this brings hope even when their death is sudden or at a young age. As we place our candle at the altar for our loved ones in November, we are letting them go into what death really is - our finding our way to the arms of God. Words of Pope Francis: "Hope is not looking at a half-full glass, which is simply optimism, which is a human attitude that depends on many things. Hope is a gift of Jesus, of His very self. It is Christ in you, the hope for glory". This is the eternal hope which is the root of our joy even in the losses of our life.

Our Catholic Faith is our greatest treasure. To guide us to strengthen it, here are seven practices which will help: Ask God's blessing every morning. Help your neighbour in time of need. Say grace before and after meals. Ask the Saints to intercede for you. Spend time in contemplation of God's goodness. Receive Holy Communion as spiritual food for soul and strength of mind. Give thanks to God every night. God of Glory strengthen our Faith. Amen.
