Vocations Notice: Jesus steps into the lives of the disciples to make them agents of God's presence in the world (cf. Lk 5:1-11). Peter is dejected because the fishermen's work produced no catch. At the word of Christ, their nets fill to breaking point. Peter had put his faith in this "Master" that spoke with authority. He says, "At your word, I will let down the nets" (Lk 5:5).
