St Carthage was a Kerry man who set up a monastery, first in Kerry, then at Rahan and finally at Lismore in Co Waterford. The monastery at Rahan had many monks and thrived for over 40 years. The lifestyle for the monks was very severe and the monks tilled the soil manually rather than by horse and plough There are stories of efforts by his monks to get rid of Carthage saying they felt unable to be his equal in virtue and austerity. Eventually At Eastertide of the year 635 the whole community was

expelled by orders of Blathmac, the High King of Tara. St Carthage finally came to the banks of the River Blackwater, where he obtained a place for his foundation from the king of the Déisí at Lismore in Co Waterford. Although he died within a short time on 14 May 637, Lismore became a famous abbey and later a cathedral, giving its name to the diocese that since 1363 has been joined with Waterford. Saint Carthage's feast day is Monday week 15th May. Mass that evening in Killina at 7.30pm
