Pope Francis: Youth are living hope of a Church on the move The "certainty" that "Christ is alive and He wants you to be alive" has inspired Pope Francis to write to young people, "Above all," Pope Francis says in the message released on Monday, "I would like my words to be a source of renewed hope" to young people who may feel

discouraged in a world "marked by so many conflicts and so much suffering." The Holy Father assures young people that "Christ is alive and He loves you with an infinite love." The Holy Father invites them to "walk with Jesus as a friend, welcome Him into your life, and let Him share all the joys and hopes, the problems and struggles of this time in your life." He goes on to remind young people of the "great mission" they have received "to bear witness before everyone to the joy born of friendship with Christ," reminding them of his invitation to make their voices heard Living in the presence of Jesus, the Pope tells our young will allow their "memory of the past" to prove fruitful and help them to "find courage in the present" and "face the future with hope." Reminding them that they are "the living hope of the Church on the move," Pope Francis thanks our young people for their presence in and contribution to the life of the Church.
